



The Problem.

Pharma products should be available 24/7/365, because the access to remedies anytime, anywhere is a FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHT, not a privilege



Brick & Mortar pharmacies are concentrated in large urban centers



Even in large cities, pharmacies operating outside of standard business hours are an exception



The delivery of medicines is neither safe, nor economically viable and there often is an element of urgency



There is a disturbing phenomenon of shortages and the resulting household overstocking with medicines

As a result,

substantial parts of the population are deprived of access to medicines

the Solution

A **robotic** kiosk that enables users to **perform transactions** through a live connection with **remote pharmacists**, effectively **replacing the**

operations of an entire pharmacy

the process at a glance.

Call initiation

The **customer** touches the screen to initiate a video

Operator/ pharmacist connects, and consultation

begins

Product selection & availability

Through out the discussion the operator selects the products according to the symptoms/ needs and availability



Payment

Once the product list is finalized the total is calculated and the POS is activated to accept the payment by card

Delivering the products

The products are delivered one by one using the QR code printed on the box confirmation process runs to make sure that the right product is delivered



Flexibility

Ending the session

The operator confirms that the customer does not need anything else, and the device is now ready for the next customer





Once the order is **completed** a receipt is issued and uploaded to the fiscal authorities

Safety

Dispensing is controlled by pharmacists, and no medication can leave the system without a visual sign off
